Assignment Title: Culturally Responsive Community Building Narrative

Module #: Week 3

Description: Write a 3-4 page narrative that describes how you will build a culturally responsive classroom community with your students and their families. This narrative should demonstrate your understanding of culturally responsive practices and your commitment to creating an inclusive environment where all students can thrive.

Purpose: This assignment asks you to articulate your vision for classroom community, your strategies for involving families, and your approach to teaching behavioral expectations in ways that honor cultural diversity.  4. Apply culturally responsive classroom management practices by developing proactive approaches to encouraging positive behavior and responding to challenging behavior with fairness, consistency, and relationship-centered strategies.
 5. Evaluate personal beliefs and potential biases by explaining how self-reflection contributes to equitable disciplinary practices and culturally responsive decision-making.
 6. Select evidence-based classroom management techniques that foster student engagement, self-regulation, positive relationships, and an inclusive learning environment.
 7. Integrate Christian faith with culturally responsive teaching by connecting biblical principles, such as Acts 10:34–35, to the creation of a classroom community that reflects God's love, justice, dignity, and impartiality for all students.
 8. Demonstrate ethical and responsible AI use by appropriately incorporating AI for brainstorming, organization, and language refinement while ensuring that personal beliefs, instructional decisions, and faith reflections remain authentically their own.
