Instructions

Part 1: Data Analysis and Review (3-4 pages)

AI Level: Level 2 - AI-Assisted Idea Generation and Structuring 🟡

Analyze 1-2 disaggregated datasets from your school context (e.g., achievement gaps, discipline rates, attendance patterns, gifted program enrollment, special education referrals).

Requirements:

- Include the actual data being analyzed in chart/table format

- Provide a written review identifying key insights and trends
- Clearly identify disparities or inequities revealed in the data
- Connect patterns to potential systemic or cultural factors
